SUBJECT: 4TH of July After-Action Report (July 1-5, 2013)

The following is the after-action report for deployment of Police Department and other City resources for the five-day period of June 30th through July 4th. During this year's holiday period, 37 firework stands were operational compared to 38 in 2012. In addition, permits were issued for 9 block party closures compared to 4 in 2012.

The Police Department accomplished the expected operational goals with no noteworthy issues. Staffing was achieved with no overtime. Throughout the five-day period, the Police Department adequately staffed resources to; 1) handle prioritized emergency calls-for-service, 2) handle routine area calls-for-service, and 3) address specific firework related calls-for-service and proactive "hot spot" enforcement.

Police Department Staffing

Department staffing levels remained at normal levels from June 30th through July 3rd. To manage the increased calls for service on July 4th, Teams 3 & 4 began their payback day at 7:00 AM, providing seven additional officers. Team 11 began their payback day at 4:00 PM, providing an additional two officers. Teams 7 & 8 began their payback day at 7:00 PM, providing an additional ten officers. Teams 7 & 8 were dedicated directed enforcement (DE) units and the primary responders for all firework related CFS. July 4th staffing consisted of:

0700-1700 hours 4 sergeants, 14 officers

1700-1900 hours
1 lieutenant, 2 sergeants, & 11 officers
1900-2200 hours
1 lieutenant, 3 sergeants, & 21 officers

2200-0200 hours
5 sergeants, 26 officers
0200-0500 hours
4 sergeants, 15 officers

Enforcement Strategies

At the beginning of this year's firework sales period, the Police Department proactively sought out individuals who received significant complaints from their neighbors. Officers contacted and warned several residents about the dangers and criminal violations associated with the use of illegal fireworks and explosive devices. As a result, potential problems were diffused throughout the City.

The civil citation process was utilized for the enforcement of firework-related violations of the Costa Mesa Municipal Code. On July 4th, the Department fielded five *firework directed enforcement units* specifically tasked with handling firework-related calls-for-service, as well as proactive enforcement of related violations. Officers issued **38** civil citations for Costa Mesa Municipal Code violations with fines totaling approximately \$5,700, compared to 13 civil citations in 2012. All citations are scheduled for Administrative Hearings on September 3, 2013.

Calls-For-Service (CFS)

For the deployment period, Communications received **428** firework-related CFS that were handled via general broadcast (GB) to area police units, compared to 329 in 2012. Officers were dispatched and responded to **76** firework-related CFS where the reporting party requested personal contact with an officer, compared to 29 in 2012. Throughout the preceding days, CFS volume was moderate with the expected increase on July 4th. CFS on July 4th generally peaked between the hours of 8:00 PM to 11:00 PM. At no point did the CFS volume exceed staffing capabilities. The following table reflects CFS and citations for the 4th of July deployment periods over the last three years.

There were no noteworthy issues regarding fireworks or parties within city parks.

Arrests made:

- 1 drug possession arrest (11377(a) H&S)
- 1 drunk in public arrest (647(f) PC)
- 4 DUI (23152(a) CVC)
- 1 warrant
- 1 fireworks related (refusal to sign citation)
- 1 "failure to register as an arsonist" arrest (457.1(h) PC)

Fire Department

On July 4th, Fire Department Arson Investigator Blincoe was available throughout the day to assist with investigations or enforcement specific to fireworks.

The Watch Commander was responsible for liaison with Battalion Chief Kevin Diamond and Captain Brosamer, who were in charge of Fire Department operations.

During the five-day deployment period, the Fire Department responded to a total of three holiday related calls.

- A firework landed on the roof of a vacant building and was extinguished by neighbors
- A dumpster fire
- Assisted the Police Department in putting out a bonfire that was burning in the street

Public Services

For the past few years TNT, the fireworks company in town, has provided clean up of all fireworks in 8 City parks and sweeping of the associated parking lots. This service, in conjunction with the posting of all the City parks for "No Fireworks" has virtually eliminated the impact of fireworks on City parks and the hours of clean up it used to require. The main impact of the 4th of July is mainly the heavy picnic and recreational use of the parks, and the lighting of fireworks in the City streets. Park staff is typically very busy the day after the 4th, picking up litter and emptying trash cans in parks, cleaning shelters, etc. just like the day after any national holiday. This year was no different.

In addition to the impact on parks, the street sweepers typically see a lot of fireworks on the routes, and not always near curbs, so they do some additional sweeping to pickup as much of the debris as possible. Cul-de-sacs are typically very dirty, due to the higher incidence of fireworks set off when there is no thru traffic.

Overall, there was nothing out of the ordinary this year. No extra man hours spent or overtime as a result of the 4th of July holiday.

Recommendations

Based on an assessment of the $2013 - 4^{th}$ of July After-Action Report, the following are recommendations for future deployments:

- Utilize the City and PD websites, and other social media resources to massdistribute information regarding a "safe & sane" 4th of July
- Coordinate with the Mesa Consolidated Water District (MCWD) to disseminate mailers on local and state firework laws with the monthly residential billing leading up to 4th of July
- Coordinate with City Hall to create and disseminate a series of press releases focused on a "safe & sane" holiday, local and state laws, and strict enforcement by the Police Department

• Distribute additional civil citation books to increase accessibility and enforcement capabilities

Conclusion

This was the third year with the increased allowable number of days to sell/purchase fireworks. The increased staffing on July 4th was successfully accomplished through the use of 3/12 "payback" shifts. The Police Department experienced an increase of approximately 30% in total firework-related CFS compared to 2012, along with a 171% increase in total citations issued. Of the 9 city-permitted block parties, none had an adverse impact on Department resources.
