

COMMUNITY OUTREACH MEETING INVITATION 19 WEST STREETSCAPE MASTER PLAN

The City held the first Community Outreach Meeting on September 4, 2013 to gather input from residents regarding the streetscape and landscape enhancement project along West 19th Street from Newport Boulevard to the westerly City limits. The vision for West 19th Street is to enhance the sense of community and the aesthetic quality of this important corridor. This includes a greener, pedestrian friendly corridor that provides a catalyst for a more attractive environment and street-side activities like outdoor cafes. The project entails streetscape and landscape improvements such as parkway landscaping, decorative sidewalks and crosswalks, and decorative street lights and benches.


