V. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Philip Bettencourt, Planning Consultant for Newport Banning Ranch, said this project is ready for review by the City of Newport Beach as the lead public agency. VII. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

1. Planning Application PA-08-31, for Scott Laidlaw/Laidlaw Schultz Architects, authorized agent for The Crossing Church, for an amendment to Conditional Use Permit PA-99-07 to construct a 932 sq. ft. café for the church and a 21,920 sq. ft. auditorium (to replace an existing temporary structure) at the front of the property instead of the rear as originally approved, with a variance from building height requirements (30 feet maximum height allowed; 36 to 40 feet high proposed), located at 2115 Newport Boulevard, in a C2 zone. Environmental determination: exempt.

Senior Planner Mel Lee explained that staff is recommending this item be continued to the meeting of April 13, 2009.

At Deputy City Attorney Christian Bettenhausen's suggestion, the Chair asked if anyone wished to speak on this item and no one wished to do so. The Chair closed the public hearing.
