2018 Pedestrian and Biking Safety Key Facts and Statistics

- Pedestrian fatalities account for nearly 25 percent of all roadway deaths in California. ([National Highway Traffic Safety Administration](#))
- Nearly 7,000 people died in pedestrian-related traffic incidents in California between 2006 and 2015. ([Pedestrian and Bicycle Information Center](#))
- California's pedestrian fatality rate is almost 70 percent higher than the national average. ([National Highway Traffic Safety Administration](#))
- No state has more pedestrian deaths on its roadways than California. ([National Highway Traffic Safety Administration](#))
- In 2015 alone, there were 59 children (between the ages of 0 and 19) killed in pedestrian-related incidents. ([Safe Kids](#))
