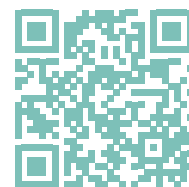

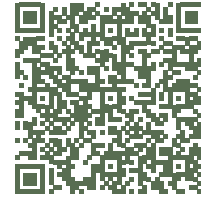

Get to know FAIRVIEW PARK'S SENSITIVE HABITATS

Fairview Park contains a number of sensitive habitats within its 208 acres of open space, which are home to several important and unique native species. These species and their habitats are vitally important to protect, for the health of the local environment and for the functioning of natural ecosystems as a whole.



FAUNA FEATURE: Yellow-rumped Warbler

DESCRIPTION The Yellow-rumped Warbler is a small bird that starts arriving in Southern California and Fairview Park in September and resides here until late April. It is one of the most abundant winter warblers found here. They have a streaky black, brown, and white appearance that can vary from bird to bird. The key identifying features are yellow spots underneath the wings, on the throat, and on the rump.

BEHAVIOR In the summer months, Yellow-rumped Warblers eat mainly insects, but in the winter they switch to eating berries and seeds. They can be seen foraging in flocks on the ground, in trees,

or in bushes. Their habitat varies and can include coastal sage scrub, chaparral, woodlands, parks, and residential areas. The Yellow-rumped Warbler can winter farther north than most other warblers because its digestive system is able to digest the wax in some berry coatings that other warblers cannot.

IS YOUR DOG LICENSED?



Each dog over 4 - months of age kept in the City of Costa Mesa must be licensed and have a current rabies vaccination.

It is required that all dogs wear the license tag at all times, attached to a collar or harness. Dog licenses are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Service dogs registered pursuant to California Food and Agriculture Code sections 30850-30854 as well as retired and active military/police dogs must still conform with local rabies control and licensing laws but are exempt from license fees. Proof of their status is required to receive this exemption.

Licenses are issued on an annual basis and it is the responsibility of the dog owner to ensure that rabies vaccines and dog licenses are kept current.

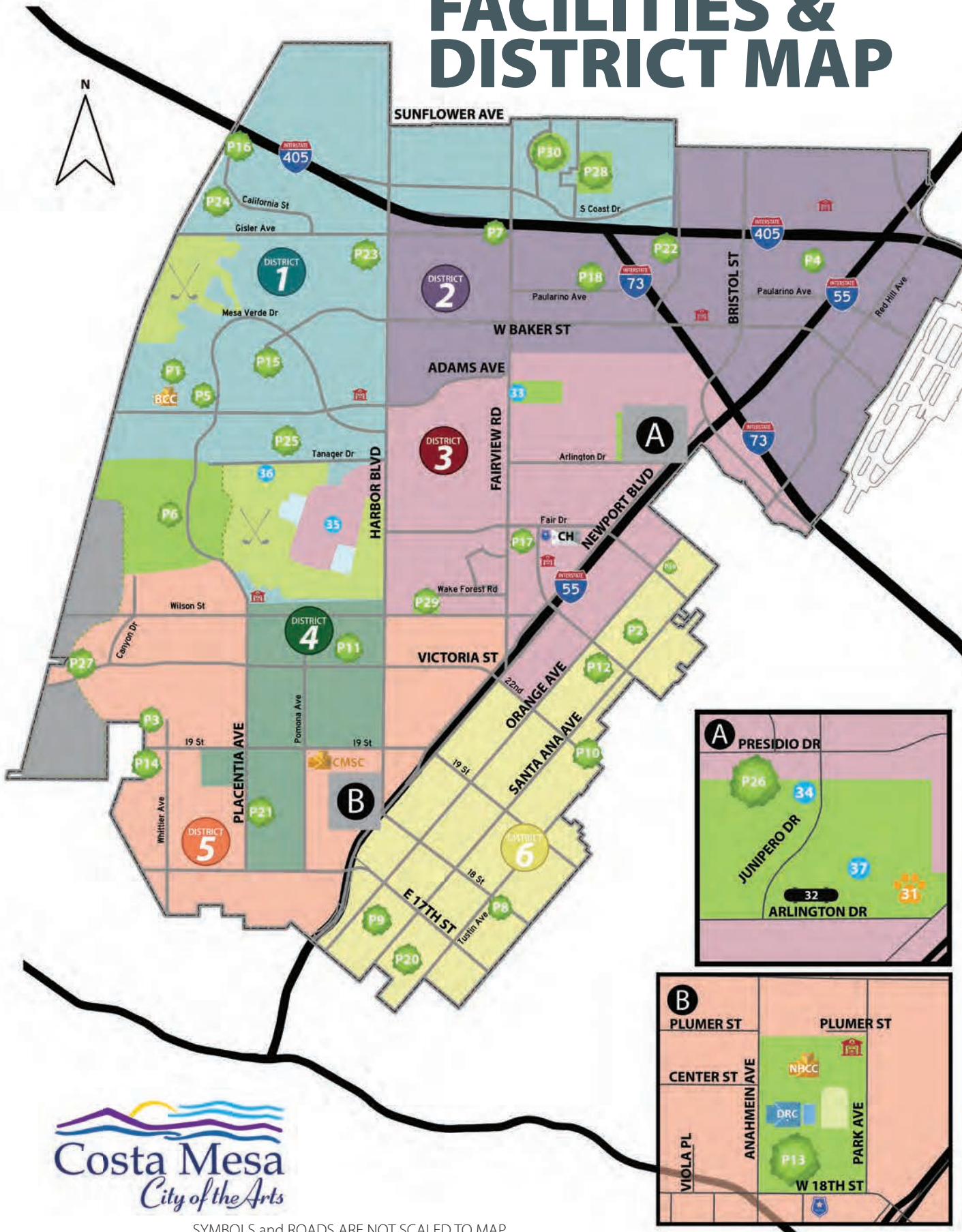
