1. CALL TO ORDER

Frank called the meeting to order at 5:55 pm

2. APPROVAL OF January 10, 2013 minutes

Motion to approve the minutes was made by Irene; seconded by Kathleen; passed unanimously.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

Tasha Mintzer and Ryan Cox from Art Cart and Tommy Martinez from Chalk Kart gave a presentation regarding their art non-profit organizations from Huntington Beach. They would like to provide their service to Costa Mesa. Lisa will provide them with Costa Mesa non-profit contract information and work with them on providing their art programs to the summer ROCKS program and at one of the Concerts in the Park.

4. OLD BUSINESS

Subcommittee Reports

A. Special Events

- 1. **SOBECA Art Walk** ARTery at the LAB on Tuesday, January 29, 2013, 6-10 pm
 - Frank informed the Committee that attendance was up, almost double, from November
 - Frank discussed extending the art portion of the ARTery by having easels of art surrounding the ARTery
 - Next event is on Tuesday, February 26 from 6-10pm
 - Theme of art will be red and white
 - Eddie will DJ outside of the ARTery while SOY participants create a piece of art
- 2. **Artist Showcase XVII** Location 1980 6-9 pm on Sat., March 16, 2013

- Seventeen artists submitted art, a total of 39 art pieces, five artists are from CM and six are new artists
- Jury Committee (Arpit, Irene and Jesse) will inform Lisa of their selected art by Friday, February 22
- 3. **Arts in the Park** Estancia Park 12-4 pm, May 11, 2013
 - Finalized planning meeting will be on Thursday, March 14 at 5:30pm in 1A

4. 60th Anniversary

- The Committee discuss their commitment for the 60th (\$7,650 was given to the Arts Program)
 - O The Committee is going to start with a 60^{th} celebration tester at the *Arts in the Park* event on May 11 (\$1,850 = for mural supplies and advisement)
 - Youth at the event will be painting 2 small murals (one of the Trains and one of Lions Park Airplane)
 - SOY participants will clean up the murals
 - Mid June-July the murals will be hanging in City Hall's <u>Youth</u>
 <u>Art Gallery</u>; art will also be provide by MIKA and displayed at City Hall on easels
 - o For the 2-3 day Kick off event (\$5,000= for CM artists live painting supplies) on June 28-30
 - The Committee will have a artists showcase gallery featuring only Costa Mesa resident artists
 - Past CM showcase artists will be invited, Frank, Irene, Jesse and Kayla will invite CM artists to showcase from their galleries
 - The Committee will also have a Chalk Artists create a couple of sidewalk pieces and a Chalk art area for youth (possibly partner with SOY or the Chalk Kart).
 - Kathleen will contact a professional chalk artist Phil Roberts and Lisa will contact the Chalk Kart
 - The Committee will also be showcasing Art Businesses (i.e. Volcom and Hurley) to have a tent of their own to display art and do live mural paintings.
 - Frank will contact Hurley and Lisa will contact Volcom
 - July SOBECA Art Walk (\$600 prize money and assisting SOBECA)
 - Frank will be working with SOBECA on expanding the July 30 Art Walk onto Randolph Street (in front of the SOBECA offices)
 - SOBECA to take the lead on this and we will assist them with adding (performance arts, youth activities, live painting, etc)
 - Displaying <u>only</u> CM Artists in the ARTery for the July Art Walk and the <u>Live pieces</u> that were created at the June Kick off event

- For this day the public will be able to vote on their favorite piece; the 1st (\$300) 2nd (\$200) and 3rd (\$100) most voted will get a cash award
- o Oct Artist Showcase XVIII at the ARTery on Oct 12 at the ARTery (\$200 advertisement)
 - Sectioning off a portion of the ARTery for just CM artists
 - Showcasing the 1st; 2nd and 3rd winners from the July Art Walk
 - CM artists live pieces from the June Kick off
- Public Affairs Manager Dan Joyce informed the Committee that the Kick off event will be June 29-30; on Fair Street and at the Fairgrounds. There will be three areas (Taste of CM with 30 restaurants; Community Stage with the fireworks show and Arts area). Fair Street will be closed to traffic.
