1. 60th Anniversary update

- ➤ Kick-Off event 6/28-30
- ➤ The Committee has commitments from (Volcom, Hurley, Location 1980, As Issued, Mesa Art and Framing, Engard Art, Kaykreative, SOY, OCC and Rock Harbor Church) to display art pieces during the 3-day event.
- > Vanguard was contacted and they are unable to participate
- After spending a month trying to coordinate art for the 30x40 gallery tent, the Committee decided that each Costa Mesa organization participating would be offered a space and provided a 10x10 EZ-up for them to display; setup and tear down their art pieces.
- ➤ The Committee has also received a verbal commitment from (Location 1980, As Issued, SOY, Rock Harbor Church, Mesa Framing and Art and SOCALPAPA) to create murals (48" x 48" wooden panels) during the 3day event.

- ➤ The Committee discussed fronting the cost for the wooden panels and to purchasing some paint to assist with the volunteer artists costs.
- ➤ Irene made a motion to budget \$6,000 out of the \$7,650 for the Kick-Off event; seconded by Arpit; passed unanimously.
- ➤ Irene made a motion that panels sold at the Art Walk, 30% would goes back to the organization/artist and 70% to the Committee's sponsorship program; seconded by Arpit; passed unanimously.

 - Lisa sent an email blast out to the Artist Directory for artists to contact Frank if they were interested in displaying art.
 - Interested artists dropped off their art piece(s), completed an artist art tag and took their piece(s) home after the event.
 - An area of the ARTery was designated for Location 1980 to display art

- The cost for the refreshments was \$252.50 (food \$102.94 and wine \$149.56)
- > SOY provide free DJ music and live entertainment (blues guitar)
- Arpit took pictures and Jesse had a video created.
- Next Showcase will be at the ARTery on Sat, Oct 12 from 6-9pm

Arts in the Park – Estancia Park 12-4pm May 11, 2013

- > \$157.35 was spent on postcards for the event
- ➤ Daily Pilot ad for May 3 and 10 will cost \$750 (funds from 60th will be used)
- Monica made a motion not to exceed \$650 for Youth Canvas project paint for the wooden panels (\$300) (colors are yellow, red, blue, white and green) wooden panels (\$200) and other supplies (brushes, plates for paint and trash bags as paint covers \$120); seconded by Irene; passed unanimously
- The Committee reviewed the passport that will be used to encourage youth to visit each organization. Completed passports will be put in an hourly raffle; winners will receive a basic art supply set. Diana made a motion to purchase four basic art supply sets (not to exceed \$120); seconded by Irene; passed unanimously.
- ➤ Tony and Lisa will meet next week to design a location map for the organizations.
