50% of pay floor for Industrial Disability Retirement (IDR)	Labor/ Workers Comp	4850.3	Safety
Continued Health benefits for survivors of officer killed in line of duty	Labor/ Workers Comp	4856	Safety
IDR - greater of: 1) 50% of final compensation, plus annuity purchased with accumulated additional contributions, if any, 2) service retirement allowance, or 3) actuarially reduced factor is under age 50	Government/ PERS	21400	Safety
1.8% per year of service, not to exceed 1/3 of final compensation for nonindustrial disability retirement	Government/ PERS	21423	Miscellaneous
75% of pay for total industrial disability retirement (IDR)	Government/ PERS	21428	Safety, Miscellaneous

### Presumptive Injuries

Presumptive Injuries: Hernia, heart trouble, or pneumonia	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212	Safety
Presumptive Injuries: cancer, including leukemia, if the member demonstrates that he or she was exposed, while in the service, to a known carcinogen	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.1	Fire
Presumptive Injury: Tuberculosis	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.6	Safety
Presumptive Injury: blood-borne infectious disease or methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus skin infection	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.8	Safety
Presumptive Injury: illness or resulting death due to exposure to a biochemical substance	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.85	Safety
Presumptive Injury: meningitis	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.9	Safety
Presumptive Injury: skin cancer	Labor/ Workers Comp	3212.11	Lifeguards
Presumptive Injury: lower back impairments for officers wearing duty belts and 5 years of service	Labor/ Workers Comp	3213.2	Police
