2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

Jason Holland from Segerstrom Center introduced himself and spoke about wanting to be involved in future committee events and endeavors. He also spoke of a meeting that he had with Justin at the center and invited committee members to take a tour of the facility.

4. OLD BUSINESS

A. Art in Public Places – Utility Box Art

a. Six boxes are planned to be completed by the next meeting if all things go as planned. The box featuring the Special Olympics artwork will be located across the street for the City Hall at the entry to the OC Fairgrounds. Frank showed artwork and spoke about the timeline. Justin will follow-up with the winners so they resubmit their original artwork.

B. Youth Art Gallery

August- Christ Lutheran Church

Self-Healing Wall- Staff presented an option for the wall covering material. It is self-healing when pierced. Council member Foley recommended that the budget comes from Maintenance, not the CAC budget. Justin will continue to research wall options and pricing.

C. ARTventure

a. Venue has been selected, Cisco Home at SOCO. They had the most flexible management and will offer attendees 20% discount on their home furnishings for the month of November. Head of the OC Fair, Kathy Krainer may also interested to partner. 200 max. people per time at the venue is a workable amount. Monica is to submit the marketing communication to subcommittee by next meeting. Justin made mention of the finalized application and handed out an event guide to the group.

D. Senior Center Art Display

a. Project update; Proposed hanging system was presented. Need 3 bids for the installation of the hanging system for the Bridge room. 2 were presented.

E. Bark Park Storage Facility Painting

a. Jason reported on the status. Painting of the building is the goal, with public works paying for the supplies. The art may come from public art submission or from graphic design staff at the City. The group discussed a proposed brick wall/monument instead of signage for dogs that have been memorialized in the current painting. Staff, Jason and Rocky are planning to attend the next Bark Park Foundation meeting.

F. Art in the Park 2016

 Andrea and Tracy are on the subcommittee for the location search and research to possibility of encompassing the possibility of a skate park and Shakespeare play component. Staff recommendation is for Civic Center Park.

1. The group discussed the option of incorporating public art into underpasses within the city. A discussion for art types followed. Staff mentioned needing approval from Caltrans. Justin will contact Caltrans about this and will bring updated information to the July meeting.
