

**CITY OF COSTA MESA  
SUMMARY OF ADOPTED URGENCY ORDINANCE 17-01**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on January 3, 2017, the City Council introduced and adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 17-01:

**AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA AMENDING AND RENAMING ARTICLE 20 (MARIJUANA AND/OR MEDICAL MARIJUANA USES AND ACTIVITIES) OF CHAPTER IX (SPECIAL LAND USE REGULATIONS) OF TITLE 13 (PLANNING ZONING AND DEVELOPMENT), SECTIONS 13-20084, 13-200.86 AND 13-200.87, OF THE COSTA MESA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO CULTIVATION OF MARIJUANA AND CERTAIN MARIJUANA RELATED USES.**

This Ordinance prohibits all marijuana uses and activities, except for those uses and activities that the City is preempted from prohibiting under state law, California Proposition 64, the "Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act", or as specifically authorized by Measure X, the "Costa Mesa Medical Marijuana Measure", codified in Chapter VI of Title 9, Chapter IX and Articles 20 and 21 of Title 13 of the Costa Mesa Municipal Code. In accordance with state law, this Ordinance permits limited indoor cultivation of marijuana for personal use that occurs within a private residence occupied exclusively by natural persons age 21 or older or inside a fully enclosed and secure lawfully existing accessory structure to a private residence.
