AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FIRSTCARBON SOLUTIONS CORPORATION

This Amendment Number Two ("Amendment") is made and entered into this 27th day of June, 2018 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and FIRSTCARBON SOLUTIONS CORPORATION, a California corporation ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an agreement on June 21, 2017 for Consultant to prepare an initial study/mitigated negative declaration for the Vanguard University Campus Master Plan (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on May 30, 2018, City and Consultant extended the term of the Agreement, amended the Scope of Services, and increased Consultant's maximum compensation; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to further amend the Scope of Services to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, City desires to increase Consultant's maximum compensation accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Scope of Services shall be amended to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit A.
- 2. Section 2.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to reflect that Consultant's total compensation shall not exceed One Hundred Two Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$102,070.00). Consultant shall be paid according to the fee schedule set forth in the Agreement, as amended, and Exhibit A of this Amendment.
- 3. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
- 4. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

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SCOPE OF WORK

As a subconsultant to FCS, Kunzman Associates, Inc. (Kunzman) will prepare a Supplemental Traffic Analysis for the project. The following task is required:

Task 1: Supplemental Traffic Analysis

Kunzman will analyze the following two additional off-site intersections based on the City-provided traffic counts:

- 1. Newport Boulevard / Fair Drive
- 2. Newport Boulevard / Vanguard Way

The above two off-site intersections will be analyzed under Existing (2018), Existing plus Project, Opening Year (2020) without Project, and Opening Year (2020) with Project Traffic Conditions. A supplemental analysis memorandum will be provided to the City prior to the June 25, 2018 Planning Commission hearing for informational purposes.

Task 2: Revise Response to Comments Document

FCS will revise the Response to Comments document prepared by FCS dated April 25, 2018 to include a summary of the Supplemental Traffic Analysis prepared by Kunzman. The summary of analysis will be included in the "Global Changes" section of the document. The Supplemental Traffic Analysis will be included as an attachment to the Response to Comments document. This task also includes additional Project Management time necessary to coordinate with the City and Kunzman in the submittal of the Supplemental Traffic Analysis and Revised Response to Comments Document. If the Supplemental Traffic Analysis requires the addition of new and/or updated mitigation measures, separate authorization will be required to update the IS/MND and recirculation of the document.
