 - b. Tree Removal Request 1070 Tulare Drive

ACTION: Motion made by Commissioner de Arakal, seconded by Commissioner Harris and carried three to one with Vice Chair Graham voting "No," to authorize the removal and replacement of the tree, per the Streetscape and Median Development Standards, Section 4.0.3 – Discretionary Removals, which would require the replacement of the tree with one (1) twenty-four inch box-size tree at 1070 Tulare Drive and two (2) fifteen gallon-size trees to be planted elsewhere on City property. The applicant would pay all removal and replacement costs.

The tree must be removed and mitigation trees provided to the City within one year from the date of final approval, after which the approval expires.

c. Tree Removal Request – 2030 Paloma Drive

- 2. The applicant shall replace the tree with one (1) twenty-four inch box-size tree to be replanted at the same address and two (2) fifteen gallon-size trees to be planted elsewhere on City property.
- 3. The applicant shall pay all removal and replacement costs.
- 4. The tree must be removed and mitigation trees planted and, as specified, provided to the City within one year from the date of final approval, after which the approval expires.
 - d. <u>Tree Removal Request 1370 Adams Avenue</u>

ACTION: Motion made by Commissioner Harris, seconded Commissioner Stiller and carried four to zero, to approve the request for the removal and replacement of nine (9) City owned parkway trees located in the public right-of-way at 1370 Adams Avenue, per the Streetscape

and Median Standards, Section 4.0.3 – Discretionary Removals, with the requirement that the trees be replaced with one (1) twenty-four inch box-size tree to planted on public property adjacent to the site and two (2) fifteen gallon-size trees to be provided to the City to be planted elsewhere on public property for each of the nine (9) trees removed. The applicant would pay all removal and replacement costs.

The trees must be removed and all mitigation trees provided to the City within one (1) year from the date of final approval, after which the approval expires.
