NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on September 3, 2019 at the Council Chambers located at 77 Fair Drive, Costa Mesa, California 92626, the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa (the "City Council") will conduct a public hearing (the "Public Hearing") at which the City Council will hear and consider information concerning the issuance, from time to time, pursuant to a plan of finance, of one or more series of tax-exempt revenue obligations by the California Enterprise Development Authority (the "Issuer") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed Seventy Five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000) (the "Obligations") for the benefit of Orange County Museum of Art, a nonprofit public benefit corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California (the "State"), and/or a related entity (the "Borrower"). The Issuer will loan the proceeds of the Obligations to the Borrower pursuant to one or more loan agreements (collectively, the "Loan Agreements"). The proceeds of the Obligations loaned to the Borrower will be applied to (a) finance the acquisition, construction, development, installation, equipping and furnishing of an approximately 53,875 square foot art museum and related and ancillary facilities located at 655 Town Center Drive (also known as 3333 Avenue of the Arts), Costa Mesa, California (the "Facilities") and (b) pay certain costs of issuance in connection with such financing. The Borrower is an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and will own and operate the Facilities in connection with its mission of enriching the lives of a diverse and changing community through modern and contemporary art. The Obligations will be paid entirely from repayments by the Borrower under the Loan Agreements.

Neither the faith and credit nor the taxing power of the City of Costa Mesa (the "City"), the State, or any other political corporation, subdivision or agency of the State is pledged to the payment of the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on, the Obligations, nor shall the City, the State or any other political corporation, subdivision or agency of the State be liable or obligated to pay the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on, the Obligations. The Public Hearing is intended to comply with the public approval requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code.

Public Comments: Public comments in either oral or written form may be presented during the public hearing.
