## RESIDENTIAL ROOFING PERMITS

Permit is for residential lightweight roofing only (under 600 lbs per 100 square foot). Any material that is over 600 lbs per 100 square foot (6psf) will require plan check over the counter.

- Two sets of stamped and signed engineering calculations to justify the structure will sufficiently carry the new load. If additional framing is required, the details must be included.
- Two sets of plans minimum on (8.5" x 11") paper indicating size, spacing, and material of additional framing required.

Tear off of any roofing materials will be required to abide by the waste hauling requirements in place that conform with the State of California requirements.

Permits that are over \$10,000 in valuation will require a Construction Access permit from the Public Works Division.

## **Existing Roofs with Existing Solar Panels**

Re-Roofing permits may be obtained if the existing solar stanchions are to remain in place during the re-roofing installation. If solar stanchions are required to be removed for the re-roofing; another permit shall be issued for the re-installation of the Solar System by a licensed solar company holding the appropriate state certifications.
