RE: Public Review Period Extended for One Metro West Draft Environmental Impact Report

On February 7, 2020 – the City released a Notice of Availability for the 45-day public review of the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the proposed One Metro West project (located at 1683 Sunflower Avenue). The DEIR was made available for public review online via the City's website as well as hard copies available at City Hall, Mesa Verde Library, and Donald Dugan Library. The public review period was anticipated to close at 5:00pm on March 23, 2020.

However – as a result of recent direction from Governor Newsom regarding COVID-19, all City facilities including City Hall, Mesa Verde Library, and Donald Dugan Library have been closed until further notice. **Due to the closure of these facilities, the DEIR public review period has been extended for an additional seven (7) days ending at 5:00pm on March 30, 2020.**
