VOTER INFORMATION

Voter Registration

To be eligible to vote in the November 3, 2020 election, you must register to vote by October 19, 2020. Voter registration applications are available in the City Clerk's office from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday or you may register online at www.ocvote.com.

You May Register to Vote in California if:

- You are a United States citizen,
- You are a resident of California,
- You are 18 years of age or older on Election Day,
- You are not in prison or on parole for a felony conviction,
- You have not been found to be mentally incompetent by a court of law.

You must Re-register if:

- You move
- You change your name
- You change your Political Party Affiliation

Election Results

Unofficial results will be available throughout Election Night, beginning at approximately 8:05 p.m. and continuing until all precinct ballots have been tallied.
