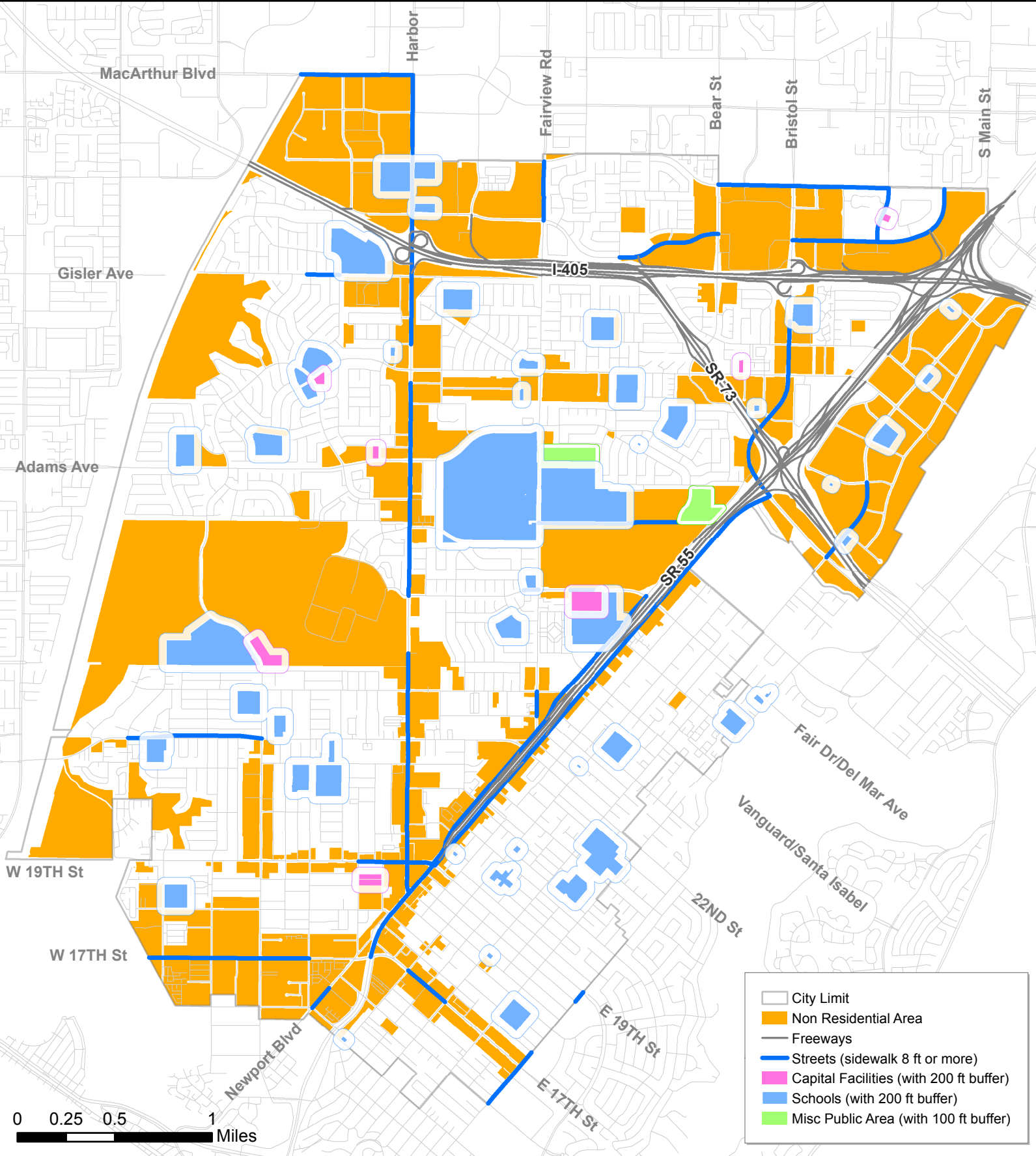




# City of Costa Mesa Sidewalk Vendor Map

# — SUMMARY OF — SIDEWALK VENDING INFORMATION

## Prohibited Vending Locations and Time:

- ▶ Stationary sidewalk vending within any residential zone
- ▶ Stationary sidewalk vending on sidewalks less than 8 feet wide
- ▶ Mobile sidewalk vending on sidewalks less than 4 feet wide
- ▶ Mobile sidewalk vending within residential zones from dusk to 8 a.m.
- ▶ Sidewalk vending within Fairview Park
- ▶ Sidewalk vending blocking access to a fire hydrant

## Restricted Vending Locations and Time:

- ▶ Sidewalks adjacent to the Orange County Fairgrounds when the Fair is in session or City notice of temporary closure
- ▶ Parks when closed or hosting a special event (i.e. the Fish Fry)
- ▶ Sidewalks

### Within 200 feet of:

- ▶ a police or fire station
- ▶ a capital facility (i.e. city hall, corp yard, library)
- ▶ any construction activities on/in public right-of-way
- ▶ a public/private school, places of worship or child day-care facility

### Within 100 feet of:

- ▶ a intersection of a street and sidewalk
- ▶ a public picnic area, playground area or playground equipment
- ▶ a dog park (if vending food)
- ▶ Jack Hammett Sports complex

### Within 25 feet of:

- ▶ a public swimming pool
- ▶ curb designated as white, yellow, green, blue or red zone, or a bus zone
- ▶ automated teller machine (ATM)
- ▶ driveway, alley or entrance to a parking lot or garage
- ▶ entrance or exit to a building, structure or facility
- ▶ storm water catchment basin
- ▶ trash receptacle, bike rack, bench, bus stop, restroom or other public use items
- ▶ Costa Mesa Skatepark
- ▶ any public community center, athletic fields or courts
