Description: Zoning Application 20-21 is a request to modify the previously approved CUP (PA-19-01); specifically, the applicant requests to expand the packaging area, to add additional products, and to add a distribution element to the operation of the facility. No cultivation or dispensing of marijuana is authorized by the approved CUP, nor the proposed modifications.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.
