WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products; and

WHEREAS, trees in our city increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS, Costa Mesa has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the Arbor Day Foundation, and

WHEREAS, Earth Day and Arbor Day are annual reminders of the constant need for environmental awareness, stewardship, commitments, and sustainability efforts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Stephens, Mayor of the City of Costa Mesa, do hereby proclaim Thursday, April 22nd, 2021 as **Earth Day** and Friday, April 30th, 2021 as **Arbor Day** and I strongly encourage all Costa Mesa residents to join with me in acknowledging these events and participate suitably in their observance.
