Qualifications for Office:

- U.S. Citizen
- 18 years of age or older
- Registered voter residing in Costa Mesa

Getting Started Early:

Review the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) Campaign Disclosure Manual 2 for information regarding filing obligations. www.fppc.ca.gov

- File FPPC Form 501 Candidate Intention Statement with the City Clerk before receiving contributions or spending your own funds.
- Open a bank account if you plan to receive contributions from others or you plan to expend personal funds totaling \$2,000 or more.
- File FPPC Form 410 Statement of Organization with the Secretary of State within 10 days of receiving \$2,000 in contributions. File a copy of Form 410 with the City Clerk.

The following information is intended to assist residents who are considering running for Costa Mesa City Council.

CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD

The filing period begins on July 15, 2024 and ends on August 9, 2024. If an incumbent does not file by August 9, the filing period will be extended to August 14, 2024 at 5:00 pm, for candidates other than the incumbents.

A Candidate Handbook, including Official Nomination Papers and Campaign Filing information, will be available by appointment with the City Clerk beginning July 15, 2024.

STEP 2: Complete nomination papers & collect signatures.
