Item 5b: Website Updates

MORE Program is administered by California Department of Housing and Community Development and provides funding to finance activities that will improve the conditions of a mobile home park:

- Mobile home Park Acquisition, Conversion, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction, or Replacement;
- Remediation of Mobile home Park Health and Safety Deficiencies or Violations
- Mobile home Park Replacement for Disaster Response
- Assist Residents with needed repairs or upgrades to their individual Mobile homes
- Application Period June 30, 2023- June 30, 2024 (or until all funds are awarded; over \$133 million awarded and approximately \$2.9 million available)



Item 5c: Communication Strategy

- Informational Pamphlet
 - Focused mailers to mobile home park residents, owners, and managers
 - Tri-fold with information in English and Spanish
 - Announces website as an informational hub





Item 5c: Communication Strategy

- The pamphlet highlights the Committee's intent, meeting information and resources
