Guidelines for CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE Approval

1. Certificate should have a current date of issue.
 2. The ***“insured”*** on the Certificate should match the ***permittee’s name***.
 3. The insurance company affording coverage should have a ***Best’s rating of “B – V” or better***. Ratings below this level (rating B) or financial size (V) should be reviewed and approved by the Risk Manager.
 4. **General and Auto Liability**
 - Minimum Limits: \$1 million per occurrence, bodily injury and/or property damage.
 - ❖ 5. **Worker’s Compensation**
 - No Minimum limits – can be ‘statutory’ or a specified limit of any amount.
 - **Note:** If sole proprietor with no employees, complete and sign the ***“Exemption from Workers Compensation Declaration”*** form in lieu of proof of insurance.
 6. ***“City of Costa Mesa”*** named as an ***“additional insured”*** under the general liability policy, as respect to all work under the permit(s).
 7. ***30 days*** notice of cancellation
 8. ***“City of Costa Mesa”*** should always be listed as the ***“Certificate holder”***.
 9. Certificate is signed by an authorized representative of the insurance company.

Oversize Load

Permit Conditions

TO THE OPERATOR/APPLICANT

The following is a list of regulations that must be followed during the moving of any oversize vehicle/load within the City of Costa Mesa. The regulations and approved permit must be carried with the vehicle/load to which they apply, at the time of, and during the moving process (35783 CVC). The approved permit only permits the moving of the vehicle/load described, within the City of Costa Mesa, and does not authorize, allow, or imply that it can be moved into another City. If the vehicle/load is to be moved into another city, a permit from that city must be obtained. If the vehicle/load is to be moved onto a State highway, a permit from the California Department of Transportation is required (which includes Highway 55/Newport Boulevard).

The following measurements regarding height, width, and length are to be taken from the greatest distance on the vehicle/load to which they apply.

WIDTH

If width is 8'6" or less, enter "legal."

If width is over 8'6" to 12':

Conditions

1. "Wide Load" signs, front and rear of moving vehicle.
2. Red flags (16" square) at all four corners of vehicle.

If width is over 12' to 15':

Conditions

1. "Wide Load" signs, front and rear of moving vehicle.
2. Red flags (16" square) at all four corners of vehicle.
3. One escort vehicle to rear (following), which shall have in view to traffic following a "Wide Load Ahead" sign, and a rotating yellow light visible to the traffic following. The light shall remain on.

If width is over 15':

Conditions

1. "Wide Load" signs, front and rear of moving vehicle.
2. Red flags (16" square) at all four corners of vehicle.
3. Two (2) escort vehicles, one to the front (leading) and one to the rear (following), which shall have in view to traffic approaching and following a "Wide Load Ahead" sign, and a rotating yellow light visible to traffic approaching. The light shall remain on.
4. Move is permitted at nighttime only, normally from 12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Other hours shall require approval from the Transportation Services Division.

HEIGHT

If height is 14' or less, enter "legal."

If height is over 14' to 17':

Condition

1. "Check Overhead Clearance" must be noted as a condition.

If height is over 17':

Conditions

1. Front escort vehicle with vertical measuring device
2. Move is permitted at nighttime only, normally from 12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Other hours shall require approval from the Transportation Services Division

LENGTH

Enter "legal" if under maximum legal length of 40' for single vehicle, 75' for combination.

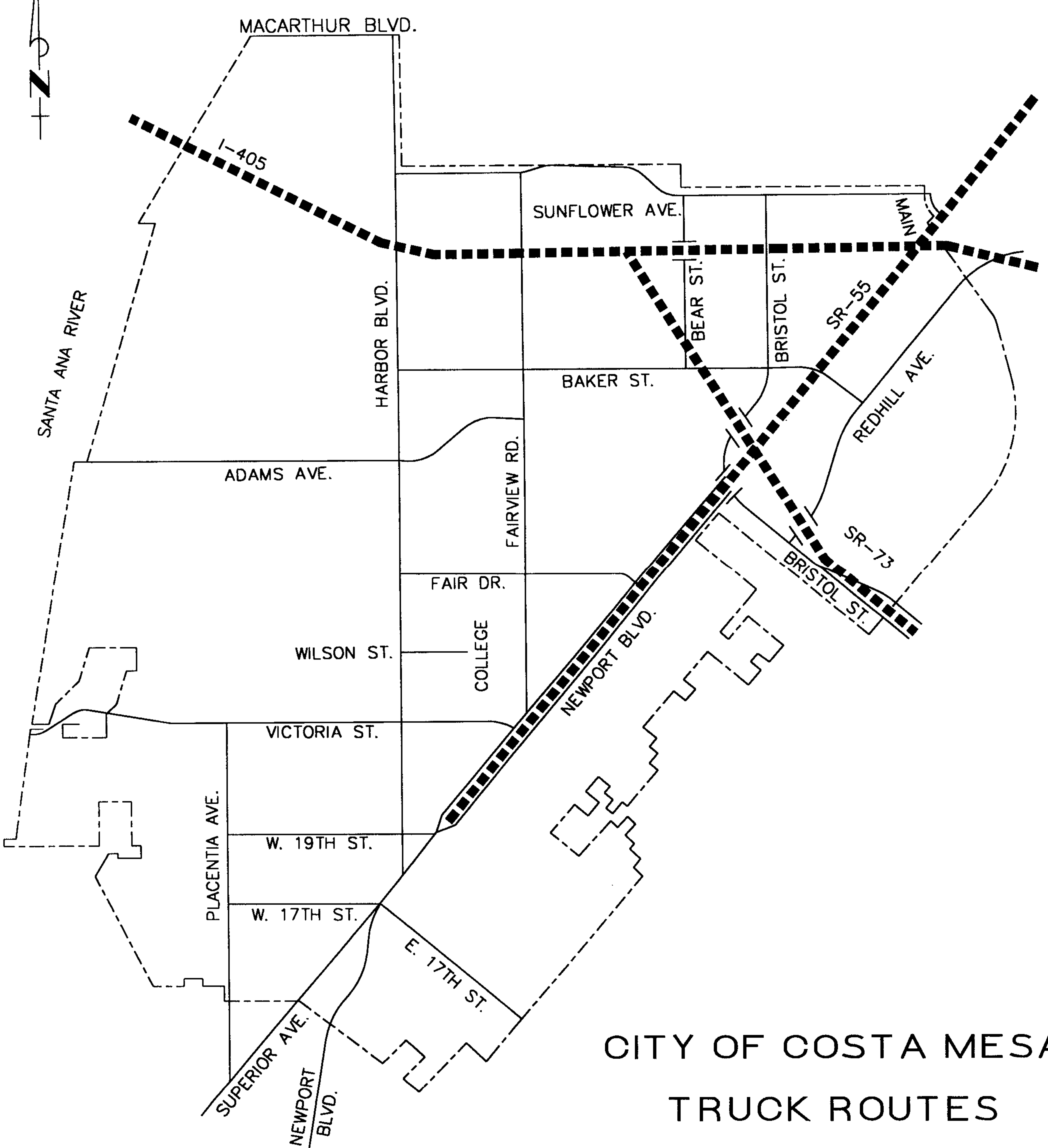
1. Any vehicle with a single kingpin combination between 75' to 100'.
2. Any vehicle combination of truck, tractor and jeep/semi-trailers coupled together (multi-kingpin) between 110' to 115'.
3. Any combination of truck tractor, jeep and semi-trailers coupled together (multi-kingpin) with articulating rear steering on the rear semi-trailer between 125' to 135'.

Condition: One (1) Pilot Car Required.

1. Any vehicle with a single kingpin combination exceeding 100'.
2. Any vehicle combination of truck, tractor and jeep/semi-trailers coupled together (multi-kingpin) exceeding 115'.
3. Any combination of truck, tractor, jeep and semi-trailers coupled together (multi-kingpin) with articulating rear steering on the rear semi-trailer exceeding 135'.

Condition: Two (2) Pilot Cars Required.
