



Community Chili Cook-off

Instructions for Contestants:

You may participate as an individual or as part of a team. Please be at the check in table at the entrance to Halecrest Park no later than 11:30 a.m. Each booth will have a long table to be shared by two contestants, and two chairs. **If you want your own table please specify.** We will supply spoons and tasting cups for anyone who wants to taste.

You will need to bring and do the following:

1. Two large crock-pots full of your homemade chili. The more you make the more people that get to taste it and the more people that can vote.
2. A serving utensil
3. Any condiments that will make your chili taste great, chips, cheese, Tabasco, onions, sour cream, etc...
4. Any signs or decorations you may want for your booth; there will be a prize for best décor.
5. You will be required to man your booth from 12 p.m.- 2 p.m. or until you run out of Chili.
6. Votes will be counted at 2:30 p.m. and winners will be announced at 3:00 p.m.

Judging will start at 12:15 p.m. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, voted on by officials, as well as a People's Choice award, voted on by your friends and neighbors.
