

Quiz - How Safe and Secure Are You?

 □ Did you lock your car when you left it in the parking lot this morning or evening? □ If you are the last to leave at night, do you lock the door to your office? □ Do you always try to park in well lit and well traveled areas?
Do you insist on identification from repairpersons who come to your home or
office? Are you extra alert while they are there?
☐ Do you keep your purse/wallet with you at all times or locked in a drawer or closet?
☐ If something suspicious or frightening happened—a stranger loitering near the
door, a burglary, a theft—do you know the telephone numbers for the police and
fire departments or security?
☐ Do you shred important papers before discarding them in the wastebasket?
☐ Do you avoid letting telephone callers know that you're at your home or office
alone?
Would you know how to respond if you were attacked or threatened?
☐ At home, do you lock your doors and windows when you're away (even for a
minute) or sleeping?
Do you have your checks automatically deposited?
Do you trust your gut instinct?
Do you vary your routine?
Do you carry limited amounts of cash?
☐ Do you have your cell phone programmed with police department non-
emergency numbers?

If you answered "yes" to all 15 questions, congratulations! You're helping to make this a safer community for us all. A score of 10 or more indicates you are fairly alert and aware, but could use a little practice.
